4. What does the first beast, a lion with eagle's wings, represent?
5. What happens to the wings of the first beast, and what does this symbolize?
6. Describe the second beast, a bear. What does it represent, and what do the three ribs in its mouth signify?
7. What does the third beast, a leopard with four wings and four heads, symbolize, and how does it relate to Alexander the Great and his empire?

8. How is the fourth beast different from the other three, and what empire does it represent?

9. What do the ten horns on the fourth beast symbolize?

10. Who or what is represented by the little horn that grows up among the ten horns?

11. Who is the Ancient of Days, and what do His white clothing and hair symbolize?

12. What do the flames and wheels on His throne represent?

13. Who is the Son of Man described in Daniel's vision, and what is given to Him?

14. According to the vision, what will happen to the fourth beast and its horns?

15. How does the vision of the Ancient of Days and the Son of Man provide comfort and hope to believers?

16. What lessons can we learn from Daniel's vision about God's sovereignty and the ultimate victory of His kingdom?
